## Introduction

Longcliffe Quarries is committed to acquiring goods and services for its customers without causing harm to others. In so doing, Longcliffe Quarries is committed to supporting the UK Government's Action Plan to implement the UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights.

This Statement is designed to satisfy the requirements of Part 6 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015, by informing our employees, suppliers, other third party partners and customers about Longcliffe Quarries and its Statement with respect to modern slavery, human trafficking, forced and bonded labour and labour rights violations in its supply chains.

Although, as a business, Longcliffe Quarries turns over far less than the threshold for businesses required to publish a statement under the Act, Longcliffe Quarries Board considers that our customer's spend through its supply agreements warrants a statement on the risks inherent in our supply chains and the steps we are taking to address them, in line with Longcliffe Quarries practices in sustainable and responsible procurement.



## Our categories

Longcliffe Quarries supply chains mainly fall under 4 categories, which are:

- Labour
- Sub- Contractors
- Suppliers of equipment and services
- Supplier of parts

Longcliffe Quarries is committed to ensure that:

1. Employment is freely chosen;
2. Freedom of association and the right to collective bargaining are respected;
3. Working conditions are safe and hygienic.
4. Child labour shall not be used.
5. Living wages are paid.
6. Working hours are not excessive.

7. No discrimination is practised.
8. Regular employment is provided.
9. No harsh or inhumane treatment is allowed.
